

It's with great sadness that I inform everyone that former CLC Potomac Region member Tom Smith passed away recently. He was the owner of Prime Tours & Travel, Inc. in Camp Springs, MD. They had two 1941 Cadillacs in their fleet, including a 1941 Series 75 Seven Passenger Formal Sedan (pictured below) that was shipped new to Capitol Cadillac on December 4, 1940 and sold to the Mayflower Hotel in Washington, DC. It was used by the hotel until 1947. Tom, the fifth owner, purchased the car in October 2006, using it for many weddings and anniversaries, and bringing it to many car shows at its home dealership where it won Best of Show at the Spring 2008 Capitol Cadillac / CLC Potomac Region Car Show. In 2009, the car was featured in the movie *My One and Only* starring Renée Zellweger

All ballots must be received by the CLC Board Election address no later than Friday, March 16th. The Region sends their condolences to the family of Tom Smith, who recently passed away. Tom, a former PR member, was the owner of a 1941 Series 75 Seven Pass. Formal Sedan that was sold by Capitol Cadillac. SECRETARY'S REPORT: The Minutes from the November 2017 meeting were not read since they were published and distributed to all members in the December 2017 newsletter.

TREASURER'S REPORT: The Treasurer's Report covered the time period from the beginning of January 2018 to date. Car Show Rules

- Rain or Shine: The car show will take place rain or shine. No refunds.
- Safety: If a vehicle has fluid drips or leaks, the owner must bring absorbent material or drip pans to avoid slippery conditions and to protect the showroom floor or show field parking lot. The Potomac Region reserves the right to prevent any cars with excessive fluid leaks from entering the show field. It is recommended that a working fire extinguisher be in every vehicle.
- Judging / Parking Rules: The Potomac Region reserves the right 1) to determine each vehicle's judging class and 2) each vehicle's placement in the show field. There will be no parking on the grassy areas whatsoever, due to sprinkler heads and possible rut damage. Vehicles will be peer judged by the individual owners of the registered cars. Registrants will be able to judge vehicles in all classes, including their own. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be given to winning vehicles in each class depending upon the number of vehicles registered in each class.
- Lunch Tickets: Each registered car owner will receive one free lunch ticket. The lunch ticket will entitle the person to receive the following from **Red, Hot & Blue**, who will be serving food:
 - 1) One Beef, Chicken or Pork Sandwich
 - 2) One Side order of Beans or Potato Salad and Cole Slaw
 - 3) One Drink including bottle water

Anyone without a lunch ticket will pay Red, Hot & Blue directly at the time of their purchase.
