



FIFTH ANNUAL CLC SOUTH FLORDIA REGION FALL CAR SHOW BY LYNN GARDNER



They were already giving out the awards, so I quickly took some photos of some of the winners and the cars.

There were about 50 cars in attendance. The Region and the Ed Morse dealership did a great job promoting the Club and the show, locally and on the internet. In addition, there were banners on the main road and two outstanding cars on display in the showroom for a couple of weeks prior: a 1961 Biarritz (pictured below right) and a 1958 Biarritz. Also, Ed Morse had tents set up with refreshments and registration, as well as for a few vendors. A nice food truck was on the lot, plus members filled the back of an Escalade with toys for Toys for Tots (pictured below left).

Approximately half the cars were customs or modified. There were some outstanding restored original cars, but the most outstanding ones were customs or modified. 
